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SECTION I - Physicians by Medical Specialty

This section defines the major medical specialties, listing the name, address and telephone number of each practicing physician. All city addresses are Vero Beach, unless noted otherwise as Sebastian (Seb.).



ALLERGY AND IMMUNOLOGY

Diagnosis and treatment involves the management of disorders related to the immune system. Including allergic reactions to foods, drugs, chemicals, insect stings and pollens. Allergic conditions include hay fever, asthma, hives, dermatitis, eczema and acquired immune deficiency diseases. These conditions range from the very common to the very rare, spanning all ages and encompassing various organ systems.

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ANESTHESIOLOGY

The administering of drugs to help ensure the safety of patients undergoing surgery. The anesthesiologist provides care for the patient to prevent the pain and distress they would otherwise experience. This may involve general anesthesia ("putting the patient to sleep"), sedation (intravenous medications to make the patient calm and/or unaware) or regional anesthesia (injections of local anesthetic near nerves to "numb up" the part of the body being operated on (i.e. nerve blocks or spinal/epidural injections).

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CARDIOLOGY

A subspecialty of Internal Medicine that specializes in diseases of the heart, lungs, and blood vessels and manages complex cardiac conditions such as heart attacks and life-threatening, abnormal heartbeat rhythms.

Diagnostic procedures include interpretation of electrocardiograms, echo cardiograms, performance and interpretation of stress tests and cardiac catheterization. The cardiologist evaluates the need for cardiac surgery.

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CRITICAL /INTENSIVE CARE MEDICINE

A branch of medicine concerned with the diagnosis and management of life-threatening conditions that may require sophisticated organ support and invasive monitoring.

Patients requiring intensive care may require support for instability (hypertension/hypotension), airway or respiratory compromise (such as ventilator support), acute renal failure, potentially lethal cardiac arrhythmias, or the cumulative effects of multiple organ failure, more commonly referred to now as multiple organ dysfunction syndrome. They may also be admitted for intensive/invasive monitoring, such as the crucial hours after major surgery when deemed too unstable to transfer to a less intensively monitored unit.

Dermatology

Diagnosis and treatment of benign and malignant disorders of the skin, mouth, external genitalia, hair, and nails.

Skin cancers, melanomas, moles, and other tumors of the skin, contact dermatitis, and other manifestations of systemic infectious diseases are treated. Also includes management of cosmetic disorders of the skin, such as hair loss and scars.

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ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY

Study of the electrical properties of biological cells and tissues. EP is a branch of cardiology that deals with diagnosis and treatment of heart rhythm disorders.

ENDOCRINOLOGY

Evaluation and treatment of disorders of the internal (endocrine) glands, such as the thyroid and adrenal glands. Also deals with disorders such as diabetes, metabolic and nutritional disorders, pituitary diseases and menstrual and sexual problems.

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FACIAL PLASTIC SURGERY

The reconstruction and repair of physical deformities that are present at birth or caused by burns, injuries, disease, cancer or aging. It is a means of restoring and improving, both function and personal appearance. Facial plastic surgery uses a variety of techniques to remove or reposition tissue, including surgical incision and excision, electrosurgery, chemosurgery, laser surgery and dermabrasion. FAMILY PRACTICE MEDICINE

The prevention, diagnosis and treatment of a wide variety of common illnesses and injuries. Focusing on the continuing and comprehensive health care for the individual and family across all ages, genders, diseases, and parts of the body. The goal is to provide personal, comprehensive, and continuing care for the individual in the context of the family and the community. Some physicians specialize in geriatric medicine, advising and treating older patients on disorders common to aging.

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GASTROENTEROLOGY

Concentrates on diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the digestive organs including the stomach, bowels, liver and gallbladder. Treats conditions such as abdominal pain, ulcers, diarrhea, cancer, and jaundice and performs complex diagnostic and therapeutic procedures using endoscopes to see internal organs.

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GERIATRIC MEDICINE

A specialty that focuses on medical issues and diseases of aging, and of old age. Treating people over the age of 60 who are either healthy or have multiple medical issues. Medical care becomes more complex as you age and encounter more medical conditions. Diseases and disorders of multiple disabilities such as dementia, diabetes, cerebrovascular and cardiovascular conditions, osteoporosis and arthritis.

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HEMATOLOGY AND ONCOLOGY

Hematology is a subspecialty of Internal Medicine or Pathology with additional training that specializes in diseases of the blood, spleen and lymph glands. This specialist treats conditions such as anemia, clotting disorders, sickle cell disease, hemophilia, leukemia, and lymphoma.

Oncology is a subspecialty of Internal Medicine that specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of all types of cancer and other benign and malignant tumors. This specialist decides on and administers chemotherapy for malignancy, as well as consults with surgeons and radiotherapists on other treatments for cancer.

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HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICINE

Treatment is focused on the immediate decision-making and action necessary to prevent death or any further disability; immediate initial recognition and evaluation of acute illness or injury and the provision of appropriate short-term care and treatment.

Emergency physicians are responsible for initiating investigations and interventions to diagnose and/or treat patients in the acute phase (including initial resuscitation and stabilization), coordinating care with physicians from other specialities, and making decisions regarding a patient's need for hospital admission, observation, or discharge.

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INTEGRATIVE MEDICINE

Combines the most well-researched conventional medicine with the most well-researched, evidence-based complementary therapies to achieve the appropriate care for each person.

Integrative medicine can help people who have symptoms such as fatigue, anxiety and pain. It can help people deal with conditions such as cancer, headaches and fibromyalgia.

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INTERNAL MEDICINE

Emphasis is on the prevention, diagnosis, and comprehensive care management of adult diseases. Physicians or Internists are skilled in the management of patients who have undifferentiated or multi-system disease processes. Heart disease, diabetes, lung and digestive diseases frequently are managed. Travel medicine, including consultation and vaccinations. There are many sub-specialties within internal medicine.

PHYSICAL MEDICINE AND REHABILITATION

Also known as **physiatry** or **rehabilitation medicine**, or **physical and rehabilitation medicine** (**PRM**) is a branch of medicine that aims to enhance and restore functional ability and quality of life to those with physical impairments or disabilities. Specializing in restoring optimal function to people with impairments caused by stroke, arthritis, head injury, spinal cord injury, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease and cerebral palsy. Includes pain management and disability evaluations.

PLASTIC SURGERY

Surgery to correct functional and cosmetic deformities of the face, head, body and extremities. Repairs scars or burned skin, reconstructs structures destroyed by cancer or accidents, performs surgery to correct congenital abnormalities or to improve the appearance of a part of the body. Includes cosmetic surgery and surgery related to reconstruction; breast reduction or breast lift; head and neck cancer; skin cancer, including melanomas; hand surgery; cleft lip and palate; eyelid ptosis surgery; maxillofacial surgery; reconstructive nasal surgery; body contouring (i.e., liposuction); and management of open or chronic wounds, including pressure sores and leg ulcers. PSYCHIATRY

Psychiatrists are trained medical doctors. Devoted to the diagnosis, prevention, study and treatment of mental disorders. These include various abnormalities related to mood, behavior, cognition and perceptions. Including emotional disorders, depression, anxiety disorders, substance abuse, developmental disabilities and sexual dysfunctions. They can prescribe medications and spend much of their time with patients on medication management as a course of treatment. Psychiatrists attend medical school and are trained in general medicine. After earning an MD, they practice four years of residency training in psychiatry.



SECTION IX- Skilled Nursing Facilities

Skilled nursing facilities are legally classified and licensed as such by the state of Florida.

All facilities listed provide full nursing care to meet a variety of needs.

The nursing facilities differ in size and environment. All of them welcome inquiries and provide on-site tours and information.

The patient's physician will often be involved in the decision to be admitted to a nursing facility, but will not select the facility. The physician must write an order for nursing facility care for those covered by Medicare or Medicaid. Prospective nursing facilities should be visited before selection and assessment made for criteria such as:

- · Fees and insurance coverage
- Physical facilities and environment
- · Services provided, including amenities
- · Staff size and duties

The patient or family should try to talk with families of people who are in nursing facilities. Asking questions of the nursing facility staff is very important.

* Long-Term Care Insurance for custodial care in a nursing facility is available through private insurance carriers. Custodial care is not covered by Medicare or most Medicare Supplement policies. Such insurance, if indicated by personal finances and other criteria, should be purchased before the applicant requires care.

SECTION XI - Home Health Care Services

Home health care providers include state licensed companies and independent health care professionals. Listed below are types of companies licensed by the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration to provide services in the home.

Medicare reimbursed intermittent service companies: These companies are licensed to receive Medicare reimbursement. Their services must be ordered by a physician, and you must be homebound to be eligible. The services are intermittent, meaning services are provided for certain times per week for a certain length of time. These Medicare agencies will provide nursing care; physical, speech, occupational respiratory and IV therapy; nutritional guidance and medical social services in the patients home or place of residence. When your condition has improved, and you have met your goals, Medicare services are discontinued until you need them and are eligible again.

Private duty custodial service companies: These services are custodial meaning you can request the service for as many hours and as many days as you need. A doctor's order is not needed. The services are private pay, however, as Medicare will not pay for custodial care. Some long term health care policies and some VA benefits will reimburse these custodial services. These home health companies may provide home health aides and homemaker/companion services in the patient's home or place of residence. There are three types of licenses given for private duty companies. They include agencies, registries and companion services.

Types of private duty companies: As mentioned previously, there are three licenses issued for private duty companies: agencies, registries, and companion companies. The company's license number letters will differentiate the distinction. HHA – agency. NR – registry. HCS – companion.

Agencies - Use their own employees to provide services. These employees are directly supervised by a Registered Nurse, and the employees are covered by worker's compensation and the company's liability policy. Services may include nursing, home health aide, and companion care.

Types of Home Healthcare Services

Social Work

Social workers and case managers are specially trained and knowledgeable about available community resources, social and psychological needs, and family management. Responsibilities include evaluation of home environment and family network, eligibility for federal or state financial support programs, recruitment and coordination of appropriate home care services, psychological counseling, emotional problem solving, overall monitoring of home care plan.

Nursing Care

Services are provided by Registered Nurses (RNs) and Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs). General services include:

- Observation of patient and evaluation of conditions. Management of care plan.
- Education and training to help patient understand and implement treatment program.
- · Supervise LPNs and CNAs (Certified Nursing Assistants).
- · Administer specific treatment programs.

SECTION XI - Home Health Care Services

Rehabilitative Therapies

Services are provided by licensed physical therapists (LPTs), occupational therapists (OTs), speech therapists and respiratory therapists.

- Physical Therapy: Helps restore function or prevent loss following surgery, illness, or physical injury. Examples of treatment include therapeutic exercise, traction, massage, gait training to restore lost ability to walk, use of prosthetic devices, ultrasound therapy and whirlpool.
- Occupational Therapy: Helps patient accomplish daily living independence through education and training in personal care, maximize functions with disability, developing coping techniques and vocational training.
- Speech Therapy: Enables patient to communicate by education and training in techniques to overcome speech problems caused by injury or neurological disease.
- Respiratory Therapy: Overcomes respiratory problems caused by illness or chronic disease by training and help in the use and maintenance of breathing aids and administration of medication.



Home Health Aide Care

Services are provided by CNAs and/or Home Health Aides (HHAs).

- Bathing, dressing, grooming, general hygiene.
- Assistance with ambulation, feeding, meal preparation, bed linen changes and positioning in bed.
- Help in managing incontinence.
- Help with routine exercise and rehabilitation therapy programs.
- Maintain medication schedule.

Nutritional Services

Services provided by Registered Dietitians (RD) and RNs specializing in diabetes. Enhances health by counseling patients requiring special nutrition therapy and education. Monitoring insulin therapy and training diabetics in nutrition is involved.

Homemaker Services

Services normally provided by home health care agencies that screen, supervise and bond their employees. Services relieve patient of homemaking while recovering from illness or injury, or who have progressive disability. Service can include shopping, cooking, house cleaning, companionship, household management and general monitoring of well-being.

Proper disposal of expired or unwanted prescription and overthe-counter medications protects the health of the community by preventing accidental overdose and potential abuse of these medications. It also protects our water supply and environment.

HOW TO SAFELY DISPOSE OF MEDICATIONS:



- 1. Keep the medicines in the original container.

 This will help identify the contents if they are accidentally ingested.
- 2. Mark out your name and prescription number for safety.
- 3. For pills: add water or soda to start dissolving them. For liquids: add something inedible like cat litter or dirt.
- 4. Close the lid and secure with duct or packing tape.
- 5. Place the bottle(s) inside an opaque (non see-through) container like a detergent container.
- 6. Tape the container closed.
- 7. Hide the container in the trash.
- 8. Do not put in the blue recycling cart.


DRUG TAKE-BACK PROGRAMS

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Blue Alert: The Florida Blue Alert is designed to notify the public of critical information when a law enforcement officer is killed, suffered serious bodily injury, or is missing while in the line of duty and the suspect, who is considered to pose an imminent threat to the public, is still at large.

Amber Alert: AnAmber Alertisan emergency message issued when "a law enforcement agency determines that a child under the age of 18 has been abducted" and is in "imminent danger," the Department of Justice (DOJ) explains. The "AMBER" stands for "America's Missing: Broadcast Emergency Response."





Purple Alert: The person who is the subject of a Purple Alert must have an intellectual or developmental disability or suffer from a brain injury and/or physical, mental or emotional disability that is not related to substance abuse.

The Purple Alert alert is the newest alert added in 2022.

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
